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Dear Parent/Carer

Welcome back to school life after a long, and hopefully enjoyable, summer break. As you are now aware, your child is being taught this year by myself (Mrs Lee) and Mrs Sanderson. I will be teaching all day Mondays and Tuesdays plus Wednesday mornings; Mrs Sanderson will be teaching Wednesday afternoons plus all day Thursdays and Fridays. Miss Rashid will be supporting this year.

The details you need to know about our class are as follows:

- PE days are Tuesdays and Wednesdays. Please can you make sure your child has their appropriate PE kit on the day and are preferably earring free. If they do wear earrings on a PE day, they must be able to remove them independently. Anyone with hair longer than their shoulders must put their hair up.
- If your child is in Y4, they will be swimming on Tuesdays so will need to bring a small bag containing their swimming costume or lycra trunks (swimming shorts are not allowed), a towel and a swimming cap.
