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Dear Parents/Carers

I would like to welcome your child to class 5/6 where I will be teaching and Mrs Shaikh will be supporting this year. Below is some information you will need to know for our class!

PE will take place on Thursdays and Fridays. Please ensure kits are in school for these days, although if preferable to you, children can leave their PE kit in school on their peg until the next holiday. There will be no swimming lessons for class 5/6. Just a reminder that we ask all children with pierced ears only to wear studs. Children cannot wear earrings for PE and therefore need to be able to remove them independently. We would advise children not to wear earrings on Thursdays and Fridays to save time and to prevent earrings being lost. If children want their ears newly pierced, could you please consider leaving this until next July at the start of the 6 weeks holiday.

We will be sending homework home every Friday to be returned by the following Wednesday. This is an opportunity for you to work together with your child to support them in their learning and to talk to them about what we have been doing in school. Your child will bring spellings home every Friday for a test the following Friday. Children will also be bringing a school reading book home. These will be changed as and when they are finished so the books need to be at school every day. Book bags are available to be purchased from the school office if desired at a cost of £3.50. All children will always have a reading book so if there is not one coming home and you would like to read with your child, then please ask them to bring it from their tray.

Our class will visit the school library every Wednesday. Please encourage your children to choose a book that they can enjoy alone or with you at home. Please ensure children have library books with them EVERY Wednesday. If children want to keep the same library book, they still need to bring it every Wednesday to get it scanned for the new week.
